



Postdoctoral position MicroRNA and male fertility preservation

The Research Laboratory in Human Reproduction and the Laboratory of Physiology and Pharmacology are two research laboratories within the Faculty of Medicine at the Université libre de Bruxelles, located at campus Erasme, Brussels, Belgium. Candidates should hold a master degree in Biomedical or Medical Sciences, Biology or Molecular Biology, and have a PhD degree in reproduction field (basic sciences).
